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## NEW PHOTO BOOTH OPTIONS

We now offer 3 new photo booth options to go along with our Traditional Photo Booths and Green Screen Photo Booths. The new options feature our new 360° Spin Booth, Ring Digital Booth and Mirror Photo Booth.

Limited slots are available for these 3 new options, so if you would like to add or change your package, please click the **Modify/Add Services** link on the **Client Tools Page** at [flashjamdjs.com](http://flashjamdjs.com) by **March 7th**. The 360° Spin and Ring Digital Booths are the same price as the Traditional and Green Screen Booths; however, prints are **not** included. The Mirror Booth is slightly higher.

## REMOTE OR EXTENDED WIRELESS SPEAKERS

If you need music played in a different room or part of your venue (say for cocktails) we can accommodate these logistics with **Remote Speakers**. These are independent from the main music sound system which allows us to control what is played using a mobile device or connected source.

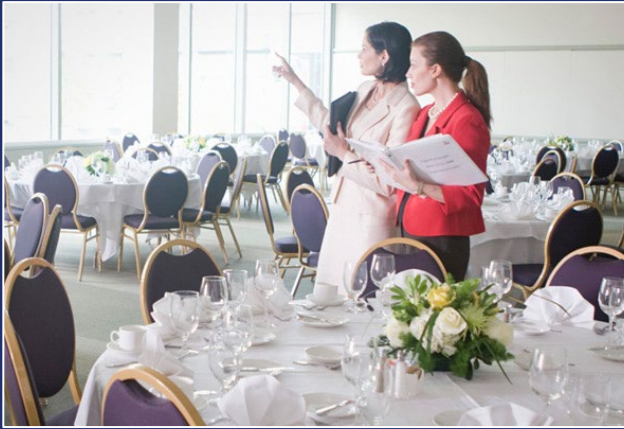
If you need to **extend** the sound of the main sound system to different areas of your venue without cords running along the floor, this is a little more complex. The solution is our **Wireless Extended Speakers**. If you are unsure which would be most appropriate reach out to us via email or telephone.

## MUSIC CONTENT CHOICE

By default, all music played during our events are radio-edits. For those clients wishing to have unedited (explicit) music played at their event, we can accommodate this request under the stipulations below:

1. The event cannot be open to all ages—no children under 18 in attendance.
2. The general public cannot have access to the event space. This includes multi-room venues, venues attached to hotels or public spaces, and outdoor venues located near residential property.
3. The venue must allow for explicit music to be played.

You can make these choices within the **Itinerary Builder**.



## EVENT PLANNERS & THIRD PARTIES

We will work in conjunction with on-site and off-site event planners/coordinators without interfering with their duties. We require the same consideration; we expect event planners/coordinators to perform their duties without interference or supervision of our performance and responsibilities.

During the live event, we ask that you communicate with us directly any issues or modifications from the discussed itinerary. Reliance on the integrity of third-party communication can no longer be considered as people have become overly self-serving.

## SAVE or SUBMIT the ITINERARY?

When completing the sections within the online Itinerary Builder, you have the option to save or submit the form at the bottom of each page.

Many clients are clicking the **SUBMIT** button when they should be selecting the **SAVE FOR LATER** option.

You should only click the **SUBMIT** button when you are satisfied with your entries and do not foresee the need to make any changes...at least not before receiving a formatted draft from us. You should also be **within 60 days** of your event date **before** submitting your itinerary.

When using the **SAVE FOR LATER** option, you are sent a link via email which allows you to return to a specific section, exactly where you left off. The idea is to construct your itinerary as a "*work in-progress*", then submit it once you are ready to work with us on a draft.

Once a section of the Itinerary Builder is submitted, you cannot edit the form. It is now in our queue awaiting the creation of a formatted Word document.

To summarize: Click the **SAVE FOR LATER** button to go back later to modify, change, or edit. Click the **SUBMIT** button when you are within 60 days of your event, and ready to receive a formatted draft—which you can then make necessary changes directly onto the document.
